

## PACIFIC RED SNAPPER "Rock Cod"

"Snapper" is a name known across the country as a firm, mild, and slightly pink fillet of fish. However, the "Pacific Red Snapper" name can be used as an alternate name for up to 59 known species of common rockfish. These fish are one of the most important commercial fishing products from the Pacific coast. Fillets range in size from under one pound to several pounds, combined with the mild flavor, these qualities allow use in a wide variety of recipes. Most restaurants will use some species of cod for their fish & chip orders. Chefs with very particular taste prefer Red Snapper. But don't only think of battered or breaded fish recipes for this product, when broiled or grilled, the flavor is sufficient alone for a healthy main course.
